

## **Application for World Sailing Residency Certificate**

Eligible sailors must apply to World Sailing CEO Andy Hunt and World Sailing Head of Sailing Competitions Antonio Gonzalez de la Madrid for the World Sailing Residency Waiver Certificate as follows:

### **Step 1:**

To be eligible for consideration for a Residency Waiver/Certificate (as per World Sailing Regulation 19.11) from World Sailing the sailor must produce proof of the following:

- Australian residency for more than three (3) consecutive years.
- That they have been a member of Australian Sailing and an affiliated club for more than three (3) years
- Must not have represented another country in the past three (3) years.

### **Step 2:**

The sailor must then send all of the relevant documentation (as per World Sailing Regulation 19.12) to World Sailing CEO Andy Hunt ([andy.hunt@sailing.org](mailto:andy.hunt@sailing.org)) and World Sailing Head of Sailing Competitions Antonio Gonzalez de la Madrid ([antonio.lamadrid@sailing.org](mailto:antonio.lamadrid@sailing.org)) for consideration and cc Australian Sailing CEO John Lee ([john.lee@sailing.org.au](mailto:john.lee@sailing.org.au)) & Australian Sailing Performance Manager Coaching & Technology Caroline Brisebois ([caroline.brisebois@sailing.org.au](mailto:caroline.brisebois@sailing.org.au)) into all communications with World Sailing.

### **Step 3:**

Once World Sailing make a decision, provide Australian Sailing CEO & Performance Manager Coaching & Technology with a copy of the World Sailing Waiver (or otherwise) no later than **20<sup>th</sup> December 2017**.
